

# Mulching

*Good Earth proudly offers a wide variety of landscaping mulches to beautify and protect your property. We offer hardwood mulch, pine nuggets and mini-nuggets, natural and colored cedar, dyed mulches and garden stones.*

**Shredded Hardwood Mulch** is bark from oak, cherry and maple trees that is triple shredded. It is naturally aged to provide a dark brown color. Shredded hardwood mulch is excellent for sloped areas. Holds moisture and deters weed growth. Comes in 3 cu ft bags.

**Black Shredded** is a shredded mulch that is dyed black for long lasting color. Available in 2 cu ft bags.

**Pine Bark Nuggets** range from 1 ¼" to 3 ½" in diameter. Available in 2 cu ft bags.

**Pine Bark Mini Nuggets** are a smaller bark chip ranging from ¾" to 2" in diameter. Comes in 2 cu ft bags.

**Canadian Natural Cedar Mulch** mulch comes from Canada and is natural medium-deep brown mulch, aging to a greyish-brown with time. Cedar is a natural insect repellent and is naturally aromatic. Available in 2 cu ft bags.

**Red Cedar Mulch** is shredded cedar that is dyed red for long lasting color. Available in 2 cu ft bags.

**Garden Stones** are available in White Marble Chips, Red Rock, Pea Gravel and River Stones. Comes in 1/2 cu ft bags.

## *How many bags of Mulch?*

A simple way to figure out how many bags you will need is to first figure out your square footage you would like to cover.

Simply **multiply the length X the width** of your garden bed.

one 2 cu ft bag covers a 24 sq ft area (1 inch thick)

one 3 cu ft bag covers a 36 sq ft area (1 inch thick)

Depending on the bag size of your mulch, **divide your square footage of your garden bed by either 24 (2 cu ft bag) or 36 (3 cu ft bag)** to get the total number of bags you will need.

If you want your mulch 2 inches thick, double the amount of bags.
