Emerald Green Arborvitae	Sun	10-15' T 3-4' W	No
Schip Laurel	Sun or Shade	8-10' T 6-8' W	Yes
Japanese Plum Yew	Sun or Shade	8-10' T 4-6' W	Yes
Euonymous	Sun or Shade	6-8' T 2-5' W	No

Euonymous	Sun or Shade	4-5' T 4-5' W	No
Shamrock Holly	Sun-Part Sun	4' T 4' W	Yes
Otto Luken Cherry Laurel	Sun or Shade	3-4' T 5-6' W	Somewhat
Green Beauty Boxwood	Sun or Shade	3-4' T 3-4' W	Yes
Green Velvet Boxwood	Sun or Shade	2-3' T 2-3' W	Yes
Skimmia	Shade-Part Shade	2-5' T 3-6' W	Yes
Helleri Holly	Sun-Part Sun	2' T 3' W	Yes
Soft Touch Holly	Sun-Part Sun	2' T 2' W	Yes
